

Assembly

The sprayer is mostly assembled at the factory. Any misc. assembly needed can be referenced with the detail views later in this owner's manual.

Do not exceed recommended pressure on pump or sprayer, as it may cause hoses to burst and will shorten pump life.

Information About the Sprayer

Roller pumps are positive displacement pumps, which means that the entire solution being pumped must go somewhere or the pump will break. In this roller pumping system, solution is drawn from the tank and forced to a planned source, such as boom nozzles or handgun. The pressure is controlled by a pressure relief valve, which is a spring loaded device that controls the amount of fluid bypassed (recirculated) to the tank. The gray handle is to be tightened to increase pressure and loosened to decrease pressure.

The 'directo-valve' is the on/off control which allows the operator to manually control the solution going to the boom.

Rinse tank out of any tank residue before filling with water to test.

Testing the Sprayer

NOTE:

It is important that you test your sprayer for leakage and proper spray patterns with plain water before chemical application is attempted. This will also give you the opportunity to familiarize yourself with the operation of the sprayer, without the possibility of losing any expensive chemicals.

 Open the valve at the strainer assembly and allow water to flow to the pump. The valve is located at this point to provide the means for the strainer to be taken apart for cleaning. The valve can be shut off to prevent solution in the tank from escaping while cleaning the strainer.

CAUTION: Always be sure that the water (or solution) has reached the pump before starting your sprayer. If the pump is allowed to run dry, serious damage to the pump will result.

- 2. It is always best to start the sprayer at little or no pressure. This sprayer is equipped with a spring loaded relief valve. Turn the valve knob out to decrease pressure and in for increased pressure. The location of the relief valve and other important components may be found by referring to the exploded view drawings later in this manual.
- The tee valve in the pressure line allows "Off-On" control of fluid flow to the boom nozzles.
- 4. You may now start the PTO. Turn the tee valve to the "on" position. Let the sprayer run at low pressure until water has reached the boom nozles and all air has been purged from the boom lines.
- The pressure should now be increased to 30-40 PSI. Operate
 the sprayer at this increased pressure for 3-5 minutes,
 thoroughly testing the unit before adding chemicals. Check
 carefully for leaks.
- See tip chart in this manual for optimal performance of the boomless tips.

Operating the Sprayer

- Test the sprayer with plain water before adding chemicals to the tank.
- DO NOT EXCEED recommended speed, pressure and temperature for the sprayer and pump.
- High pressure spray can cause serious bodily injury. Handle with care. Grasp gun firmly before starting to spray. During spraying operation, hold gun firmly.
- DO NOT put hands or fingers in front of the gun or point the gun at your body or anyone else.
- Before working on, servicing or making adjustments to equipment, make sure all moving parts have stopped and all pressure in the system is relieved.
- Perform periodic cleaning, maintenance and inspection of fittings and hoses for operator safety. Replace any fittings or hoses that are shown to have defects.
- DO NOT use sprayer for pumping water or other liquid for human or animal consumption.
- 8. If equipment is used in freezing or near freezing conditions, protect pump and plumbing on sprayer from freezing. Drain liquid from system and add antifreeze.

Maintenance During/After Spraying

Periodically close the suction line valve and check the strainer and clean the screen.

Proper care and maintenance will prolong the life of your sprayer.

After use, fill the sprayer tank part way with water. Start the sprayer and allow the clear water to be pumped through the plumbing system and out through the spray nozzles. Refill the tank about half full with plain water and use FIMCO Tank Neutralizer and Cleaner and repeat cleaning instructions above (If no tank cleaner is available, you may substitute dish soap for this step, about 1-2 oz. per gallon). Flush the entire sprayer with the neutralizing/cleaning agent, then flush out one more time with plain water. Follow the chemical manufacturer's disposal instructions of all wash or rinsing water. For the boom (if applicable) remove the tips and screens from the nozzle assemblies.

Wash these items out thoroughly. Blow the orifice clean and dry. If the orifice remains clogged, clean it with a fine bristle (NOT WIRE) brush or with a toothpick. Do not damage the orifice. Water rinse and dry the tips before storing.


WARNING: Some chemicals will damage the pump valves if allowed to soak untreated for a length of time! ALWAYS flush the pump as instructed after each use. DO NOT allow chemicals to sit in the pump for extended times of idleness. Follow the chemical manufacturer's instructions on disposal of all waste water from the sprayer.

Winter Storage

Drain all water out of your sprayer, paying special attention to the pump, handgun and valve(s). These items are especially prone to damage from chemicals and freezing weather.

The sprayer should be winterized before storage by pumping a solution of automotive antifreeze (containing a rust inhibitor) through the entire plumbing system. This antifreeze solution should remain in the plumbing system during the winter months. When spring time comes and you are preparing your sprayer for the spray season, rinse the entire plumbing system out, clearing the lines of the antifreeze solution. Proper care and maintenance will prolong the life of your sprayer.


Torque Chain Attachment to a Roller Pump



A torque chain, 'S' hook, nut and bolt are included in this assembly to secure your pump during operation.


- Attach one end of the torque chain over the threaded stem of the bolt
- 2. Thread the whiz nut onto the bolt. Hand-tighten
- Thread the bolt, chain and nut 'pre-assembly' into the threaded hole on the underside of the pump. Tighten sufficiently
- 4. Affix the 'S' Hook to your frame (or hitch). Wrap the chain around the frame or hitch and 'S-Hook' it in place. Make sure this connection is very secure! Not having a good, tight connection may result in the pump spinning on your PTO shaft and damaging some components of your sprayer







Agitator Detail Inside of Tank




Strainer/Intake Under Tank




Boom Indicator Markings






