



Read and Understand the Owner's Manual completely before using this attachment. Assemble, test and use in accordance to manual instructions.

Exercise Caution in vehicle handling when using this attachment to avoid loss of control or overturning.

Do Not allow anyone to ride on or sit with you and/or ride or sit on attachment when operating. Failure to comply could result in severe injury or damage.

Keep children, bystanders and pets at a safe distance away while operating this or any attachment.

Do Not exceed 5 MPH. Towing speed should always be slow enough to maintain control. Best operating speed: 3 MPH.

Do Not attempt to aerate if ground is too wet or muddy.

Avoid holes, rocks and roots.

Do Not cross over walks or drives without first raising the aerator to the transport position.

Slow down before you turn and do not turn sharply. Use wide angle turns to ensure attachment follows path of towing vehicle.

Always operate up and down a slope, never across the face of a slope.

Slow down and use extra care on hillsides. Turf conditions can affect vehicle stability.

Keep all movement on slopes slow and gradual. Do not make sudden changes in speed, directions or turning.

Stop on level ground, disengage drives, set the parking brake and shut off engine before leaving the operator's position for any reason, including adjusting the attachment.

Keep all parts in good condition and properly installed. Fix damaged parts immediately.

Do Not modify attachment.

Always handle with care as this aerator has sharp knife points and always wear substantial footwear when operating.


Caution should be taken when towing and/or using any attachment. This attachment combined with the weight distribution, turning radius and speed of towing vehicle can result in severe injury or death, damage to towing vehicle and/or attachment, if not used properly.

Spike Aerator Information

Advantages: aerating, good for loose soil, does not create deep holes. Spike aerating is a good method even though holes produced are shallow. As grass seeds will settle when sowing on sloping surfaces, this is useful if you intend to overseed. Spike aerator helps air circulation and good water absorption. The dense matting of grass, as well as constant foot traffic cause soil to become dense, making it harder for air, nutrients and water to reach the roots of your lawn. Aerating allows water, fertilizer and air to permeate the soil and reach the roots. Benefits of aeration: soil absorbs more water, reduces soil compaction, thatch breaks down easier, lawn is more resistant to heat and drought stress, oxygen uptake of soil increases, stronger root development, fertilizer and nutrients in soil are more easily used by grass and water runoff decreases significantly. As a general rule, aerating once per year is a good idea, typically around the same time each year.

Spike aerator has been mostly assembled at the factory for your convenience. It has been packaged "inverted" in the box. Remove the parts to the unit from the carton. Refer to the exploded view and parts list to help identify the parts and follow instructions below for assembly.

Place the frame on a flat surface, leaving the unit "inverted". This will be the best position for the tongue attachment procedure.



3 Easy Steps to Attach Tongue and Handle to Unit

Step 1 - Tongue & Hitch Attachment:


The tongue bars will be located under the inverted unit. Remove (2) locknuts, (2) bolts and clevis hitch from the parts bag.


Assemble the tongue to the hitch clevis with hex bolts and whiz nuts.

Step 2 - Tongue Attachment to Unit:


Assemble the tongue from Step 1 to the unit with (4) hex bolts and whiz nuts, as shown.







Finally, bolt handle to the handle mount plate, using (2) bolts and lock-nuts.


Tighten bolts and nuts.





Unit is now ready to use.





Operation

Aerating produces holes in the ground that allows water, fertilizer and air to permeate the soil and reach the roots. It is recommended that the lawn be mowed and clippings removed prior to aerating. Water the ground as necessary. This will soften up the soil for the aerator to penetrate the ground easier.

Spike aerator should be attached to tow vehicle or tractor on a level surface and the wheels should be in the lowered position (handle in the locked position).

The best operating speed is 3 MPH or less..

Once you are ready to use your aerator, use a low gear and then disengage the wheels by moving the handle out of the locked position. Once you start moving, the spikes will be forced into the ground. Speed should only be increased as ground conditions permit. Aeration should be done in a straight line.

Lawn aeration is not accomplished in a single pass. Spike aerator should be run over the lawn two or three times, alternating the direction by 90 degrees, which will improve the aeration effect


Caution: Do not turn sharply as this may damage the ground. The top tray provides a place for you to put weights. More weight will allow the tines to penetrate the ground deeper. Maximum weight is approx. 175 lbs.. Do not pull your aerator over hard surfaces with the wheels disengaged! This will damage the spikes.

Lubricate wheels and oil the spool assemblies and shafts as needed. Coat exposed metal with light oil to prevent rust.

Clean dirt off of aerator after each use and store in a dry area. Be careful of sharp edges when cleaning.


Proper care and maintenance will prolong the life of your attachment.

Caution - Danger: Spikes are sharp and can cause injury, store with plugs facing the wall or ground.



Warranty

LIMITED WARRANTY FOR NEW FIMCO, IND. EQUIPMENT

WHO MAY USE THIS LIMITED WARRANTY. This limited warranty (the "Limited Warranty") is provided by Fimco, Ind. to the original purchaser ("you") of the Equipment (as defined below) from Fimco, Ind. or one of Fimco, Ind.'s authorized dealers. This Limited Warranty does not apply to any subsequent owner or other transferee of the Equipment. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS, AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS WHICH VARY FROM STATE TO STATE.

WHAT THIS LIMITED WARRANTY COVERS AND FOR HOW LONG. Fimco, Ind. warrants that any new Equipment will be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of **one (1) year** (homeowner), **90 days** (commercial user), after delivery of the Equipment to you (the "Warranty Period"). The Warranty Period is not extended if Fimco, Ind. repairs or replaces the Equipment.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED BY THIS LIMITED WARRANTY. This Limited Warranty does not apply to: (1) used Equipment; (2) any Equipment that has been altered, changed, repaired or treated since its delivery to you, other than by Fimco, Ind. or its authorized dealers; (3) damage or depreciation due to normal wear and tear; (4) defects or damage due to failure to follow Fimco, Ind.'s operator's manual, specifications or other written instructions, or improper storage, operation, maintenance, application or installation of parts; (5) defects or damage due to misuse, accident or neglect, "acts of God" or other events beyond Fimco, Ind.'s reasonable control; (6) accessories, attachments, tools or parts that were not manufactured by Fimco, Ind., whether or not sold or operated with the Equipment; or (7) rubber parts, such as tires, hoses and grommets.

HOW TO OBTAIN WARRANTY SERVICE. To obtain warranty service under this Limited Warranty, you must (1) provide written notice to Fimco of the defect during the Warranty Period and within **thirty (30)** days after the defect becomes apparent or the repair becomes necessary, at the following address: Fimco, 1000 Fimco Lane, North Sioux City, SD 57049; and (2) make the Equipment available to Fimco or an authorized dealer within a reasonable period of time.
